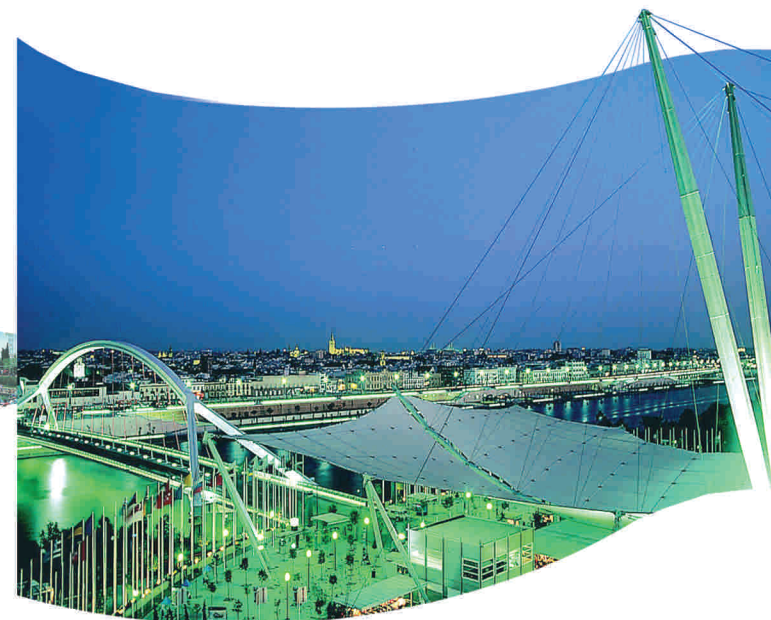

This **First International Conference** regarding **European Fluvial Cities** is designed as a multi-disciplinary forum for reflection, discussion and the provision of ideas and projects relating to rivers in urban surroundings.

Its aim is to favour the interchange of information and promote common directives for all European cities with rivers to ensure compatibility between economic and social development, the preservation of **Heritage** and respect for the **Environment**



CONDITIONS FOR THE PRESENTATION OF CONTRIBUTIONS

Scientific contributions shall be made in Power Point or Poster format. Abstracts of the same must be sent for acceptance by the Scientific Committee before 10 September 2004. The definitive acceptance and second circular will be issued to participants in mid-September.

The abstract should include the title, the authors and their place of origin. It should also include key words, introduction, research methodology, analysis and results of the study.

The total length shall be 2 DIN A4 sized pages of standard spaced lines including figures, photographs and bibliography. A blank space shall be left between each paragraph. Figures should be in jpg format and be inserted in the text either in colour or black and white. Once approved by the Scientific committee they shall be included in the two existing formats (PWP/Poster). The authors will be informed of their selection before the end of July. A paper copy of the abstracts must be sent to the Technical Secretariat together with the archive on diskette or CD-Rom, in one archive only preferably prepared using Word for Windows, and which shall specify the name of the author and the title.

The presentations in the Power-point room may not be longer than 12 slides. The posters shall measure 100cm wide x 150 cm high, and shall include the title of the same, the author(s) and the institution to which the author belongs. All text and graphics, etc, must be legible and neatly presented. Posters should not be sent to the technical Secretariat but shall be mounted on the day of inauguration of the Conference. For their presentation during the Conference, the authors need only bring the posters and or presentations. The Technical Secretariat will be responsible for all the equipment and technical support required for the exhibition.

All such contributions should be sent to the Technical Secretariat for the Congress.
