The dialogue focused on three main themes:

- Economic development: sectorial clusters and hubs;
- Work training especially for long term unemployed and low skilled job seekers;
- Urban renewal.

Conclusion of the substantive discussions

GENERAL CONCLUSION

- Doubts about cohesion policy's future (Brexit, ...)
- Without the support of EU Funds, loads of local projects won't be implemented.; EU
 Funds cover areas which are not covered by Wallonia budget.
- Priorities for investment the EU should invest in the social and not focus on the economy and employment (innovative social models for economic models such as cooperatives, co-working models), notably under the ESF funding.

ERDF

- Short implementation deadlines :
 - o Allow a positive dynamic
 - Need a transversal approach
 - Make difficult citizen participations
- Communication and transparency on the projects are essential to gain the support of citizens. But the communication costs are not supported by the EU Funds.

ESF

- The indicators are not always appropriate:
 - o indicators mainly quantitative and not qualitative
 - o indicators may be relevant for some countries but not for others
 - o indicators mainly relate to economic and growth
 - Evaluation takes place after a too short period of time

- The financial support for trainings' organization is appropriate, but there is no support for the "pre-training"
- Some projects require a financial support for a longer period than the programming period
